[13/08/01 Centenary Naval Review Update - COMBINED NAVIES MARCH](#)

SYDNEY - THURSDAY 4TH OCTOBER, 12:00 pm - 1.30 pm

The combined navies march will be led by the Maritime Commander, RADM Geoff Smith, and is the largest naval contingent since World War II to march through the city - about 7000 marchers will take part including 3000 from the RAN, 3000 from ex-naval organisations and 400 Australian Navy Cadets.

The march will turn left into George Street, centrepiece of the city, passing the Sydney town Hall at 12.30pm, where The Governor of New South Wales will take the salute.

Once past the Town Hall, the march will turn right into Liverpool Street and end at Tumbalong Park in the Darling Harbour precinct, where participants will be treated to an Australian Style 'Sausage Sizzle'.
