AFTER 80 years, it is hard to think that anything can be new on Anzac Day. History, however, will be made in Brisbane this morning when the Australian flag is carried horizontally for the first time in an Anzac Day parade. The chief marshal of the Brisbane parade, Les Lupuljev, says the flag is to be carried in that position as a special mark of respect to those involved in World War I. The flag will be carried by six serving officers from the navy, army and the air force.
